COMMENTS AND INSTRUCTIONS

Violation #2 Provide cushioning materials such as mats, wood chips, or sand under the climbing equipment in the PE area. There is some sand in the area but its a very thin and compact layer under the climbing equipment.

Violation #2 Repair the damaged areas of the floor of the climbing playground equipment where its metallic mesh structure is rusted, corroded and broken, repair also the damaged areas of the playground's floor.

Code Reference FAC: Playground Equipment 64E-13.004(2)(a)(c). Playgrounds shall be constructed and maintained to permit maximum utilization of sites with elimination of sanitary and health hazards including mudholes, fragments of glass, stone and similar obstructions. Fixed playground equipment shall be anchored with substantial foundations so maximum safety is obtained. Cushioning materials such as mats, wood chips, or sand shall be used under climbing equipment, slides, and swings.

Violation #5 Replace the water damaged and/or missing drop ceiling panels in vestibule #112 outside the PE equipment storage area.

Code Reference FAC: Maintenance & Repair 64E-13.004(3)(b)(c). Buildings shall be kept clean and in good repair, free from hazardous conditions, such as loose or broken floor tiles and boards; loose moldings; loose hanging fixtures, pipes, and electric wires; and broken plaster. Furnishings and equipment shall be kept clean and in good repair, free of missing parts and hazards such as sharp edges, splinters, and protruding or rusty nails.

Violation #9 Repair or replace the mechanical ventilation system of bathrooms 036 (repeated violation) and 166-A.

Code Reference. Ventilation and air conditioning. FAC: 64E-13.004(5) (d). All occupied rooms and other rooms where odors or contaminants are generated shall be vented to the outside. FAC: 64E-13.004(5)(d) 2. Mechanical ventilation. All spaces which do not meet the requirements for natural ventilation shall be mechanically ventilated by means of electrically operated exhausts. Fans and blowers shall be sized and designed to provide the required air movement without excessive or disturbing noise.
