Remember that there will be no school from December 23rd through January 3rd. We hope all of you have safe and joyful holiday season! See you back to school on January 6th!

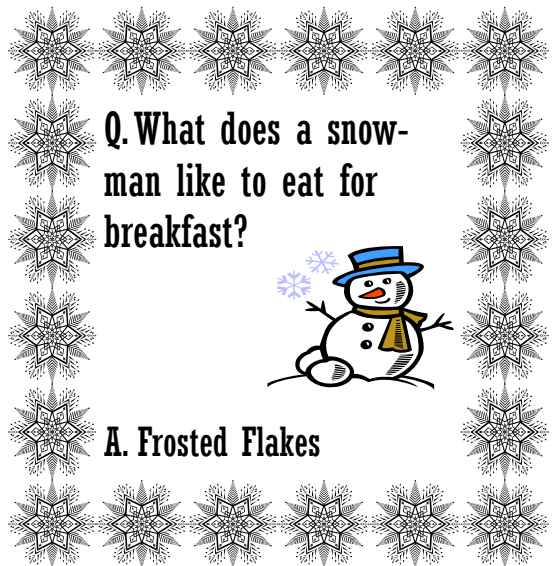
Fifth Grade Reminder
