The safety of our students is a top priority at Christina M. Eve Elementary School. In order to ensure student safety we need your cooperation with the arrival/dismissal procedures at our school. Parents may not park in the teachers parking lot or the drive-thru lanes during arrival (7:45-8:40) and/or dismissal (1:30-3:30). We ask parents to be patient and to continue to move forward to keep the line moving. Thank you in advance for your support in our efforts to ensure your child's safety.

Student attendance and behavior are of vital importance to our students' academic success. All students should arrive in school by 8:25 a.m. for the first bell.
