## A Message from Mrs. Gonzalez...

The safety of our students is a top priority at Christina M. Eve Elementary School. In order to ensure student safety we need your cooperation with the arrival/dismissal procedures at our school. The school was built with two drive-thru lanes for dropoff and pick-up. Parents may not park in the teachers parking lot or the drive-thru lanes during arrival (7:45-8:35) and/or dismissal (1:15-3:15). We ask parents to be patient and to continue to move forward to keep the line moving. Our PLC was also built with a drive thru lane. We ask that you follow the same rules at the PLC as in our main campus. Thank you in advance for your support in our efforts to ensure your child's safety.

Student attendance and behavior are of vital importance to our students' academic success. All students should arrive in school 10 minutes prior to the tardy bell. The tardy bell rings at 8:20 a.m. for Pre-K through 1st grade and at 8:35 am for 2nd through 5th grade. Please support us in our efforts. Also, take the time to review the Christina M. Christina M. Eve Elementary is a mandatory uniform school. Students are expected to wear their uniforms daily unless there is a special activity which permits them to dress differently. The uniform must include the school logo.


